

Better Boards Conference: Code of Conduct

To make the Better Boards Conference a safe, enjoyable and inclusive environment for all participants we have created this simple code of conduct which all attendees and speakers must follow. This code of conduct applies to both the online and in-person context.

Any attendees or speakers who breach this code of conduct will be removed from the event.

The Basics

- Be polite and courteous in your interactions with all other attendees.
- Treat other attendees as you yourself would like to be treated.
- Any harassment, bullying or abuse will not be tolerated.

We reserve the right to remove an attendee whose behaviour is inconsistent with the spirit of the code of conduct, even if it's something that is not explicitly forbidden by the code. In other words, if you do something that isn't listed here verbatim, but it looks or smells like something listed here, we may still remove you.

Inappropriate Communications

Attendees must not use the event platform or locale:

To violate the privacy of others, including publishing or posting other people's private and confidential information without their express permission, or collecting or gathering other people's personal information

To stalk, harass, or post direct, specific threats of violence against others

For any illegal purpose, or in violation of any laws

To send unsolicited communications, advertising, chain letters, or spam

To solicit other attendees for commercial purposes, unless expressly permitted by Better Boards

Disparage Better Boards or our partners, vendors, affiliates or other attendees

Promote or advertise products or services

Inappropriate Content

Attendees must not post, upload, share, submit, or otherwise provide content that:

- Is deceptive, fraudulent, illegal, obscene, defamatory, libellous, threatening, harmful to minors, pornographic, indecent, harassing, or hateful
- Attacks others based on their race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex, gender, sexual orientation, disability, or medical condition
- Contains viruses, bots, worms, scripting exploits, or other similar materials
- Is intended to be inflammatory
